

### **Girls Teams (League of play descriptions on page two)**

**U10 Girls Recreational** – This coach will oversee the training of all U10 girls. It is projected that the club will have 30 or more incoming players at this age group, and it is the intent of the club that these girls practice together Academy style, forming 3 teams on game day.

**U11 Girls Classic** – This coach will oversee the training of all U11 girls. It is the intent of the club that these girls practice together Academy style, and it is expected the player pool will support the formation of 2 classic teams.

**U12 Girls Classic / U12 Girls Recreational** – The expected player pool at this level will support the formation of a small classic team playing 11v11, and a small recreational team playing 8v8. It is the intent of the club for both these squads to train together under one head coach.

**U14 Girls Recreational** – At this point it is unclear whether the U14 girl's player pool is large enough to support a classic team and a recreational team, but it is the intent of the club to support a team at this level if possible.

**U14 Girls Classic** – It is anticipated this team will play in the SOCL.

### **Boys Teams (League of play descriptions on page two)**

**U10 Boys Recreational** – This coach will oversee the training of all U10 boys. It is projected that the club will have 20 or more incoming players at this age group, and it is the intent of the club that these boys practice together Academy style, forming 2 teams on game day.

**U11 Boys Classic** – This coach will oversee the training of all U11 boys. It is the intent of the club that these boys practice together Academy style. It is expected there will be enough players at this level to support 2 classic teams.

**U12 Boys Classic** – It is the intent of the club to form two equal 11v11 teams to play in the SOCL. Coaching candidates may submit an application to coach one of these teams or may submit a plan to oversee both teams.

**U14 Boys Recreational** – At this point it is unclear whether the U14 boy's player pool is large enough to support a classic team and a recreational team, but it is the intent of the club to support a team at this level if possible.

**U14 Boys Classic** – It is anticipated this team will play in the SOCL.

## **Leagues of play for ASC teams**

### U10 Recreational Boys and Girls

ASC participates at this level in the Recreational League organized by the Rogue Valley Soccer Club. Games are played 8v8 on Saturdays in Ashland or Medford.

### U12, U14 Recreational Boys and Girls

ASC participates at this level in the Grants Pass Youth Soccer Club Recreational League. Games are played 8v8 on Saturdays. Game locations may include Ashland, Talent, Medford, Central Point, and Grants Pass.

### U11, U12, U14 Classic Boys and Girls

ASC plays competitively in the Southern Oregon Classic League (SOCL). Competitive teams travel to K.Falls, Roseburg, Grants Pass, and Medford. U11 play is in the 8v8 format, while U12 / U14 play is 11v11.

### OYSA Statewide League

In some cases ASC club teams will choose to participate at the statewide level. This is a decision typically made by the coach and the parents of the players involved.
